## III. Secretary Report

The Secretary Report was presented by President Guthrie. Approval of the minutes of the last meeting as submitted to the membership via the GPA website was called for and approved.

## IV. Treasurer Report

The Treasury Report was presented by President Guthrie. The current balance for the GPA is \$8,049.39. The Treasurer Report was voted on and approved. Credit card access planning was still in progress. It was also pointed out that an invoice can be printed from the website and filled out by the user to document dues payments.

## V. Old Business

President Guthrie sounded the names of the new officers and board members for the current year. He addressed the need for a deadline of payment of dues suggesting April 1 be the deadline with a late fee associated thereafter. He also pointed out, based on a question from the floor, that donations to the GPA are tax deductible. The Tri-State Training Conference for 2027 is to be hosted by GPA and the leadership will attempt to have four location options available to the membership by the May meeting. North Carolina has not given a location but confirmed there will be a Tri-State Training Conference hosted by NCPA in 2026. It was agreed that the GPA will give them until the summer and then put a training event together to be held in Georgia.

## VI. New Business

President Guthrie spoke of the need to purge the GPA membership roster of inactive member. He also advised a better email system was being explored. It was planned for that system to be tied directly to the website.

## VII. Announcements

The next regular meeting of the Georgia Polygraph Association will be held on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 10 am. at the Douglasville Police Department. Lunch will be catered and training will be provided. A discussion ensued regarding the training topic for that meeting. A suggestion was made to focus on the new Edge software by Lafayette Instruments. It was also stated that not everyone used Lafayette instruments and maybe it would be good to have two sessions on different topics at the same time. It was also discussed that the Edge software training topic would be best left as an option at the Tri-State Seminar. No final decision was made regarding the specific training topic for the May 2026 meeting.
